As part of the year-long 75th anniversary celebration, we hosted the 2023 Legacy Day celebrating our founders, and launched the "Our History" website, [cfni.org/ourhistory](https://cfni.org/ourhistory), that showcases the organization's multi-generational history. The four publications of our quarterly magazine, "The Voice", also shared our unique historical developments along the way. CFN Worship also recorded a 75th anniversary album, which inspired a deep sense of gratitude for all the incredible things that God has done through the ministry over the years.

Nearing the end of the year, and with great fanfare, our Envision Gala, a spectacular formal event, was attended by over 400 guests, in support of the ministry's ongoing impact and vision for the future. Ministry friends, CFNI alumni and staff, along with partners and business leaders within the Dallas metroplex joined us at the historic Arts District Mansion in downtown Dallas, where we celebrated over seven decades of transformative Christian ministry.

# WHO WE ARE & WHAT WE DO



Christ For The Nations is a global non-profit organization that is changing hearts and influencing nations around the world. Since its founding in 1948, by Gordon and Freda Lindsay, our organization has spread the Gospel of Jesus through Worship, The Word and World Missions. The International Ministries programs of Christ For The Nations continue to make a global impact. So far, and with the help of giving partners, we have helped complete 12,100 church buildings in over 100 countries through the Native Church Roofing Program, provided over 64 million free Christian publications to over 120 countries, built an association of over 50 affiliated Bible schools in 30 countries, provided thousands of dollars in world relief resources, supported foreign orphanages (led by CFNI alumni), international missionaries and Israel.

In 1970, Christ For The Nations established the Institute (CFNI) as a three-year multi-generational, multicultural Bible school to train world changers who are passionately pursuing their God-given assignments for Kingdom impact. Students, and 40,000+ alumni from over 170 nations, have received training from CFNI and have gone on to serve in ministry, missions, media, education, government and businesses across the globe. Graduates of CFNI know God's Word, are devoted Christians, and love to communicate the Gospel of Jesus Christ wherever they go!

## NEW: STAFF OUTREACHES STARTED IN 2023

Golan Lindsay, CFN VP & COO, launched a new missions initiative in 2023 to provide opportunities for staff to participate in global missions. ## APSARA RAI | NEPAL

"I applied to CFNI but my visa application was rejected by the government, so I felt devastated, wondering if it was God's plan for me to go to CFNI. After my struggles to get a visa interview, I tried again and eventually got an appointment, and my visa was finally approved. Now, God is doing great miracles in my life at CFNI. I have learned so many things like discipleship, how to get along with people from different cultures, and how to create a strong relationship with the Holy Spirit. God provided everything I needed such as a laptop for school, finances, etc. I was missing my family, but God gave me loving and caring families at CFNI. God will never leave you in failed situations, but he will help you get out of them to become stronger."



## TIMOTHY ROHIDAS | INDIA

"I was raised in a ministry family in Bangalore, Karnataka, India. At college, I majored in media studies as I was not completely into ministry life. But, I was touched by God and felt there was a calling for me to share the gospel - not because of my family in ministry, but as a personal calling. Now I serve in my church's media ministry, with live streaming, mixing music, checking sound checking, editing, etc. I really want to know more about God and His kingdom, and share His words with those who don't know about Christ or the power of the Holy Spirit. Because I know CFNI trains and equips people to fulfill their God-given calling, I decided to pursue biblical studies and pastoral leadership, and God is changing my life at CFNI."

"At CFNI, I discovered the importance of vulnerability, profoundly shaping my self-perception and relationships. I've been immersed in a community setting since my arrival, and I've shared ideas, visions, and cultural experiences with others on campus. ## OUR HISTORY

As part of the 75th anniversary year, Christ For The Nations launched the “Our History” website, [cfni.org/ourhistory](https://cfni.org/ourhistory). With timelines featuring different Lindsay leaders, God’s blessings over the years, and the journey of growth into a globally recognized ministry and Bible school, this website showcases the multi-generational history and global impact of the organization.



## CFN WORSHIP

Led by our Creative Department Director, Robert Quintana, and our worship leader, Marya Adedimeji, CFNI collaborated with worship students and alumni worship leaders to record our 75th Anniversary worship album, highlighting songs sung in CFNI chapels over the decades. Through collaborative projects, CFN Worship also produced anointed worship albums in English, Portuguese, and Spanish. Worship music from Christ For The Nations is available on all major streaming platforms, and has been streamed over 22 million times globally.



## LEGACY DAY

Another celebratory event marking the 75th anniversary of Christ For The Nations was the 2023 Legacy Day. This day honored the inspiring legacy of our founders, Gordon and Freda Lindsay, and their family, Dr. Dennis and Ginger Lindsay, Golan and Krissia, Missy, and Hawni Lindsay. During this event, former Planned Parent employee-turned pro-life activist, Abby Johnson, was the recipient of the 2023 Freda Lindsay Award.



## VOICE OF HEALING & PROPHETIC CONFERENCE

The 2023 Voice of Healing and Prophetic Conference stirred the hearts of over 1,000 attendees with God’s work in America and around the world. Guest speakers such as Emma Stark, Dr. Edith Prakash, Steven Springer, and Mary Colbert inspired us to contend for miracles and transform nations with God’s presence and anointing.



## ENVISION GALA

Christ For The Nations celebrated its 75th anniversary in downtown Dallas, at The Arts District Mansion. Over 400 hundred guests came together to support the CFN International Scholarship Fund. As a highlight, the first ‘Wayne Myers Spirit of Generosity Award’ was presented to Dr. James Marocco, in honor of his remarkable philanthropic work in the Kingdom.



## PRAYER & WORSHIP

Prayer and worship are core values of Christ For The Nations. Building on the rich legacy of his grandparents and parents, Golan Lindsay, our VP & Chief Operating Officer, continues to prioritize prayer and worship throughout our organization. Below are some special moments when staff, students, and guests united in the pursuit of the Lord.

- **Tuesday Night Encounter (TNE)** | During both semesters, a night of worship was held on the 2nd night of each month, for students, alumni, staff and guests to come together in worship.
- **All Night Prayer** | In 2023 we hosted several all-night prayer meetings, from 10pm to 6am, where students sought God for fresh revelation and pushed back the works of the enemy.
- **All Day of Worship** | The leaders of the Institute canceled all classes for one day each semester, and students, instructors, and staff pursued the Lord in worship for an entire day.
- **52-Day Prayer & Fast** | For the opening week of the fall semester, in the Institute Building, Golan Lindsay challenged students, staff, faculty, and alumni with a 52-Day Prayer & Fast. We embraced the call to lay aside our earthly needs and contended for a move of the Holy Spirit in those 52 days. The Lord showed up in our worship and prayer sessions, and gave us many amazing testimonies of supernatural encounters, healings, and deliverances.



## SPRING & FALL COMMENCEMENTS

At the CFNI spring and fall commencement ceremonies, 192 diplomas were awarded to excited students from a total of 37 countries around the world. What a testimony of God's goodness! Our graduates were from Indonesia, Ghana, Vietnam, Nepal, France, Japan, Cameroon, Sweden, and Nicaragua, and many others. Commissioned by Dr. Jeffrey Seif at fall commencement, this multinational group of spirit-filled World Changers are now pursuing their call and impacting nations for the glory of God.

### NEW: LAUNCH OF DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT

In 2023, our executive leadership established a Development Department to advance the reach of Christ For The Nations as a global missions organization and Bible school. Through strategic initiatives, this department facilitates collaboration across the organization, maintains and expands fundraising methods, and stewards existing and potential giving partners.

To share what God is doing at CFNI with our alumni and friends, the Development Department launched 'The Insider Update', a quarterly newsletter that highlights CFN events, our global missions work, student and alumni stories, and more. Each quarter, this newsletter email is read by an average of 12,000 people.

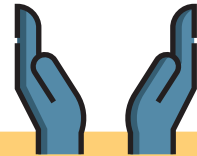

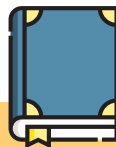

## **KENNY BROWN JR. | Alumnus 2003-2005**

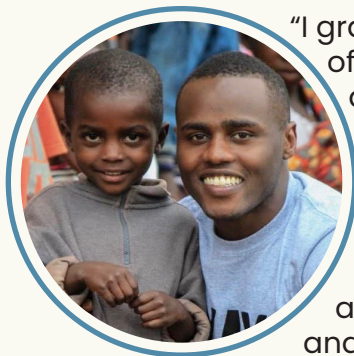
**President & Chief Operating Officer, Argent Trust Oklahoma**

“I graduated from CFNI in 2018 and felt God calling me to start a business to serve local churches. In 2022, I started ChurchCandy Marketing, which helps bring people to local churches through social media ad campaigns. God has been incredibly faithful because today we serve over 350 churches and have about 30 team members. At CFNI, God gave me the vision for ChurchCandy Marketing, not during a chapel service or prayer session, but in an Ethics in Leadership class, taught by Kiplin Batchelor.
